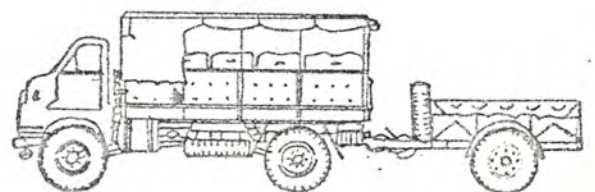
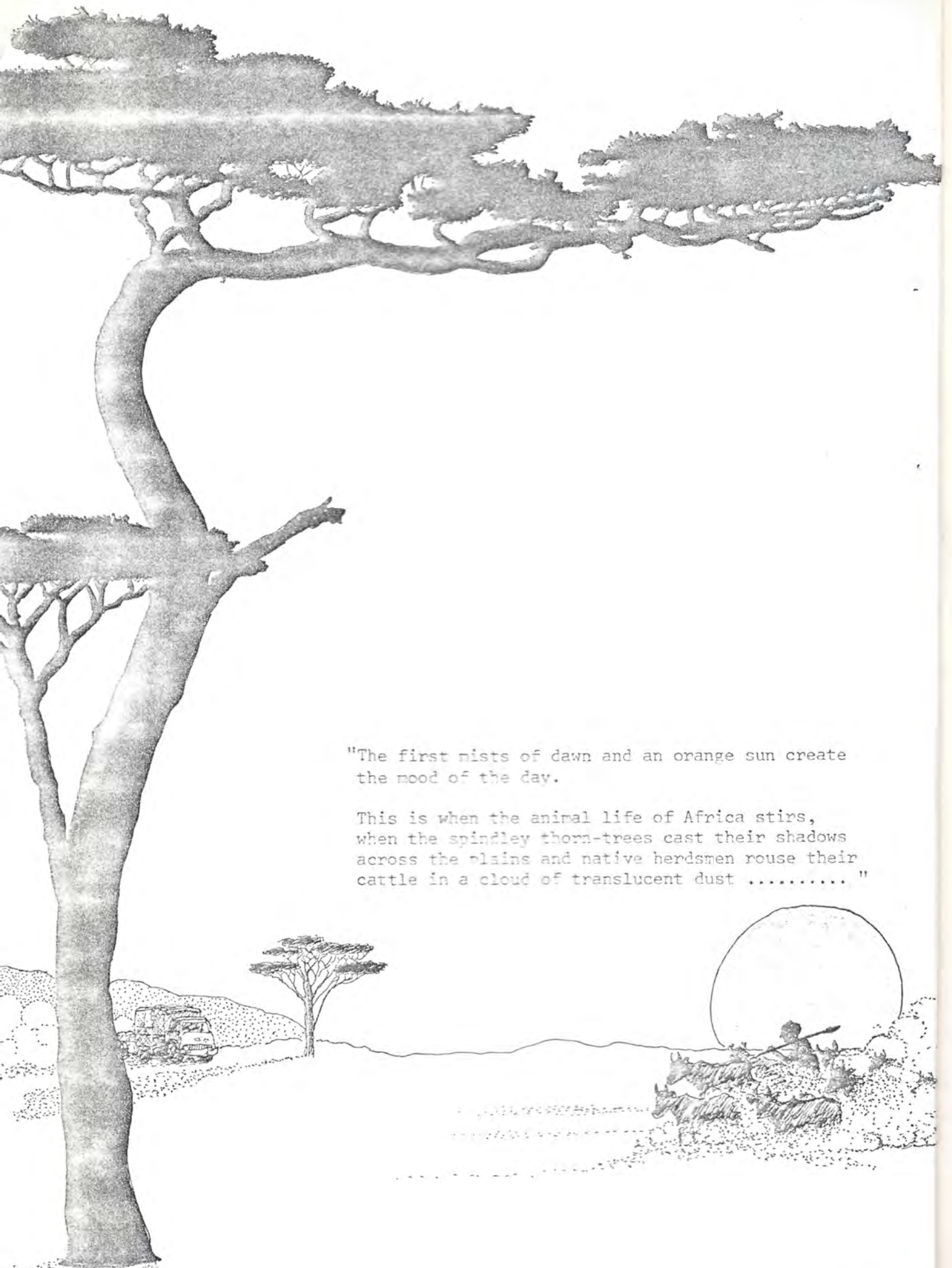

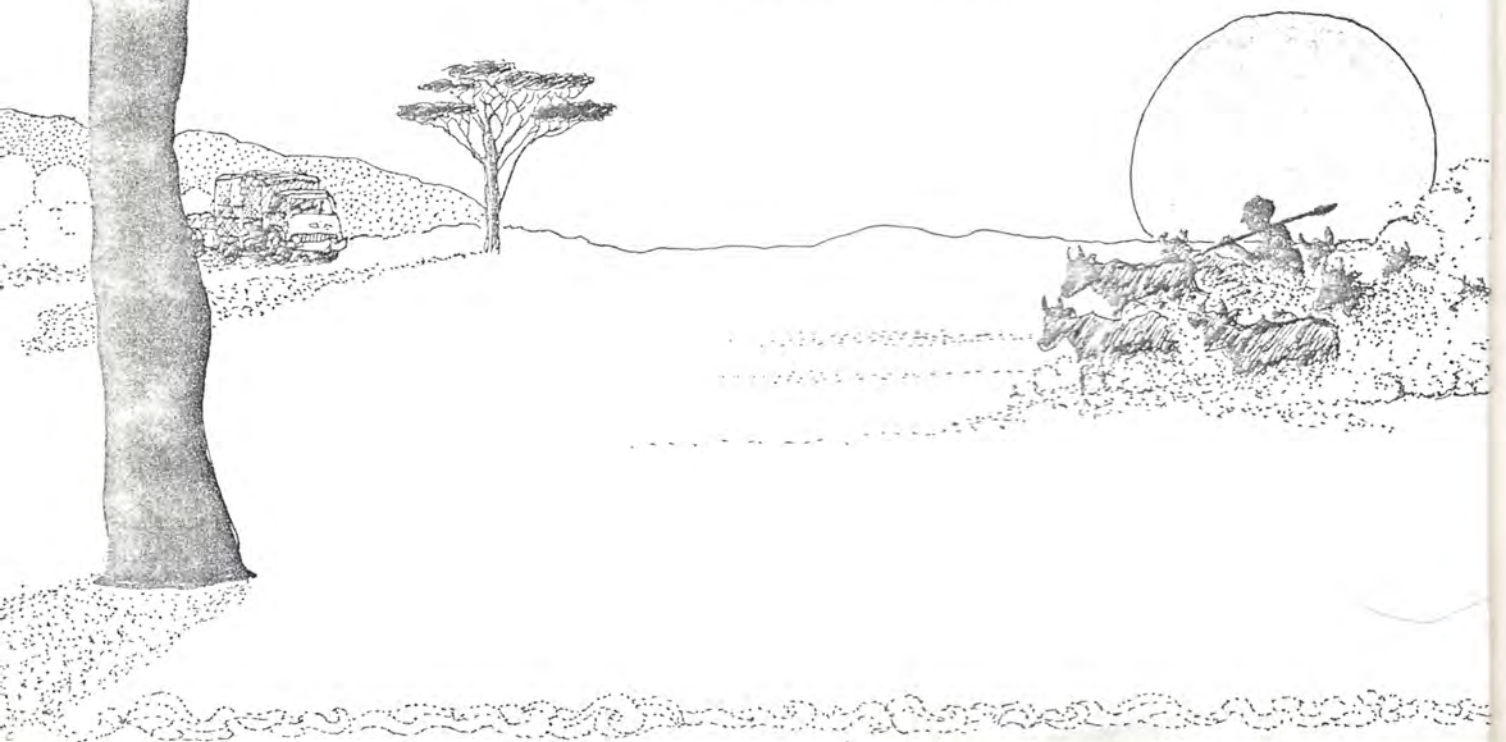

THREE WEEKS IN EAST AFRICA

After 12 years of successfully mounting long-range expeditions through Africa, Asia and South America, Encounter Overland is organising two shorter expeditions around East Africa. Even though these are a new venture for Encounter, they will be run on the same basis as our long-range expeditions, using similar vehicles and equipment, and following a flexible itinerary so as to take in the major gameparks and the beautiful Indian Ocean coastline.

In spite of the relative shortness of these expeditions, they will not be luxury guided tours where people are pampered into missing the essential character of a country by moving rapidly from hotel to hotel. One of the main aims of these safaris is to give an insight into the possibilities and enjoyment of overland travel, not staying in hotels, but preferring to camp occasionally in organized camp sites, and more often exploring the more peaceful unspoiled regions, camping wherever we choose. The emphasis on EO expeditions has been, and always will be, group participation and EO travellers must be prepared to contribute not only with their time and money, but they must also give of themselves. We know that any group is made up of distinct individuals, seeking out new experiences.

The vehicles we are using reflect the nature of the project we are involved in. They are the now famous and often imitated four wheel drive Bedford trucks which Encounter pioneered in the 1960's at our own company workshop. We have been designing and building them there ever since, continuing to improve them and always meticulously equipping them to meet our own exacting requirements for work with cross-country trailers. The unit is enormously rugged, powerful and dependable. Because it enables us to be totally self-sufficient we can get off the well worn paths and explore the wilder, more remote regions where we find places of natural splendour well out of the reach of other vehicles. The trucks have convertible tops, the sides of which can be firmly secured for complete protection when required. Usually the canvas is rolled up, giving us uninterrupted vision and plenty of fresh air and sunshine.

The Cost

You have the right to know the total amount in advance and that while on the trip, personal spending money should not be used on miscellaneous 'kitties', but should be left for your own spending!

The cost therefore includes the following :

1. Transport costs en route - everything related to our vehicles, taxes, tolls, spares, repairs, etc.
2. All camping accommodation - necessary campsite fees, etc.
3. All cooking equipment - from gas burners to knives and forks.
4. All camping equipment - including 2-person tents and campbeds.
5. Food - 3 meals daily, usually cooked ourselves and occasionally out at a local restaurant.

The only items not in the one basic price are those which you obviously cannot include because of differences in individual needs. These things are sleeping bag, personal spending money (to cover souvenirs, beers and cigarettes, etc), visas, injections and personal insurance.

Insurance

All members of our expeditions are required to have personal travel insurance. Details of a policy underwritten for Encounter Overland are available. Alternatively, you may make your own insurance arrangements but cover must be at least equivalent to that on our suggested policy. Those with family responsibilities should seek advice on an increased cover.

Passports

Passports must obviously be valid for the duration of the expedition. They should also not bear evidence of having visited South Africa, Rhodesia or Mozambique. Please contact us if you think you may have any problems with your passport.

Medical

Because International Health Certificates must be shown at embassies and borders, vaccination against smallpox, cholera and yellow fever is required. TABT inoculation (against typhoid, para-typhoid and tetanus) and Gamma Globulin injection against hepatitis are also strongly recommended.

Medical (cont'd)

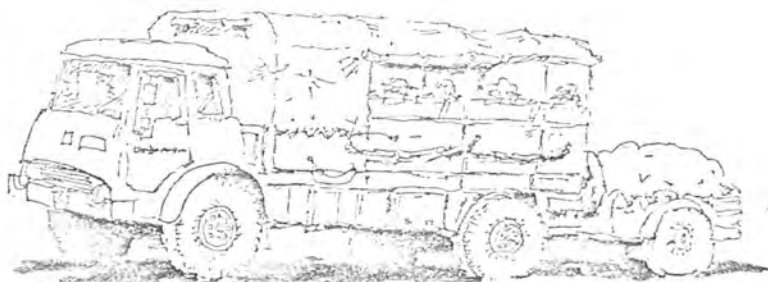
Each vehicle carries a comprehensive medical kit. These are well stocked with basics, such as anti-malarial and water purifying tablets, as well as with penicillin (or derivative) and other more sophisticated antibiotics. Our leaders are familiar with the various medical supplies, knowing when and how to use them, and also knowing qualified doctors en route. In addition, there is nearly always at least one expedition member with medical training on board.

Luggage

Without a doubt, the easiest and best way to travel is as lightly as possible, taking only what is really needed. This can, and must, be contained in three pieces of luggage :

1. a modest sized suitcase, canvas bag or rucksack :
2. a small airline type hold-all :
3. a sleeping bag roll.

If a rucksack is used, the frame must be removable to avoid wear and tear on other people's bags.

CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

(Please read these conditions carefully)

1. The deposit is made at the time of booking. The fee is accepted as a first instalment of the inclusive fare and will not be refunded unless the applicant cannot be offered a place.
2. The accepted applicant will pay the balance of the inclusive fare not later than 30 days before the departure of his/her expedition from London (or Nairobi). No money can be refunded unless the place is subsequently filled.
3. The organizers reserve the right to cancel any expedition without prior notice. In this case all monies paid will be refunded in full.
4. Tour prices and itineraries are subject to alteration without previous notice due to influences beyond the control of the organizers ; e.g. exchange rates, epidemics and political disputes.
5. Charges quoted include : living and travel by the means indicated or as may necessarily be altered by the organizers. Unless otherwise stated in the expedition details, the price of visas, personal insurance, laundry, admission fees and purely personal spending money is not included.
6. Clients will comply with all legislation and customs and foreign exchange regulations of the countries visited. Should there be any contravention the client may be asked to leave the vehicle.
7. Clients, their baggage and personal property will travel insured entirely at their own risk and subject to the terms and conditions above. Neither the organizers nor the organizer's staff nor their agents nor any organization or carrier with whom they are cooperating will be under any liability whatsoever in respect of any illness, accident or loss.
8. This contract is subject to English law and is to be interpreted under it.
